Retiree Emeriti Center Expands

The Chancellor's Office recently announced that financial support would be provided to expand the hours and services provided by the Center. After reviewing a report on the first three years of the Center's operation, Associate Chancellor Ashish Sahni communicated the Chancellor's decision to provide additional funds to increase the Center's operations.

The half-time Center Coordinator will have extra time to develop new programs, like the "My Favorite Project" initiative recently developed. (See the Retiree Emeriti website:

This increased level of service will provide all retirees and emeriti with an additional source for important information or referrals to knowledgeable UCSC contacts who can answer questions about health insurance or retiree/emeriti benefits. Bruce Lane Memoríal ξ Sílver Slug Scholarshíps by Maxíne Lane

First, we thank two very important contributors to our May scholarship luncheon - Mary Wells and Maurene Catto, who produced the very attractive program leaflet.

We now have two scholarship opportunities for deserving students, the Bruce Lane Memorial Fund for military veterans and the Silver Slug Award (new) for staff members and their dependents.

At the end of June, the Retirees Bruce Lane Memorial Endowment Fund reached \$100,450.78. After deducting funds for the scholarships, the Current Year Fund total is \$1,326.15.

The Silver Slug Award Endowment end-of-June total is \$27,076.58. We look forward to awarding scholarships to staff members and their dependents, with financial need, next May. Many will experience a better life benefiting from education afforded by these endowments.



Heads Up! Your Retiree Health Benefits May Be At Risk.

UC's Office of the President is proposing to rescind the 70% floor on UC contributions to retiree health care insurance. This proposal was on the action agenda for the July Regents meeting, but was removed due to swift and aggressive action by the leadership of CUCRA (Council of UC Retiree Associations) and their colleagues in CUCEA (Emeriti Associations) and CUCSA (Staff Assemblies) and the Academic Senate. Our representatives objected to the proposal because it was made unilaterally without any consultation with the affected stakeholders and it was a significant breach in the agreement that was part of the Report of the 2010 Post Employment Benefits Task Force.

At the time of this writing, the proposal is still active and action has been postponed to the Regents September meeting. It is anticipated that UCOP will take appropriate steps to consult with retiree representatives and faculty and staff groups during August and September. Stay tuned!
