Helpful reminder: Review copays and Rx fees

Some cost-sharing amounts are increasing in 2025. For example, the copay for office visits is changing in 2025 from \$20 to \$30 for UC Blue & Gold HMO, Kaiser HMO, UC Care (tier 1), Kaiser Senior Advantage and UC Medicare Choice (United Healthcare). Prescription drug copays in 2025 are increasing incrementally, too.
